- 24 years of Indonesian occupation
 → Let's focus on this episode

Blue print institutions

- Serious Crime Unit
- Special Panel / hybrid court
- Organized Election
- ▶ Re-established military and police
- > Semi-presidential system (gave us)

UN Transitional Administration

2 1/2 years non-elected governance

Implementation of institutions

- Lack of knowledge of cultural aspects and recent history of Timor-Leste
- Lack of consultation with (non) formal leaders
- "western" perspective and projection

CAVR Report Recommendations 2000 pages 202 recommendations → Including the need for a national reparation program.



CHEGA Recommendations

- Reform military and police
- Educate on citizenship, human rights and history
- Reinforce Ombudsman for Human Rights and Justice
- Promote non-violent methods of conflict resolution
- Search for the disappeared
- Judgment of past crimes

Truth Vs forget the past

- → Need truth:
 - victims and society; justice and guaranteed not happen in the future.
- → Forget the past:
 - Actor of past regime still continuing leading the country → by ignoring the responsibility.

Perception of Justice



Discrepancy

- 1. UN Law of the Sea (UNCLOS) vs Australia's claim on the Timor Sea oil
- 2. Indictment without persecution process (Wiranto case cs)



Challenge

- Lack of political will
- leaders in both countries (TL and Indonesia) still dominated by the old generation with "dirty hands"
- politicization of the victim as ex-combatants and avoid accountability for the rights of victims

Little Hope...

- The new prime minister of the new generation with little hope
- Before elections this year, he wants establish a special institution "Memorial" to assist the government how to implementing the recommendations of the CAVR
