Government and Woodside Reinforce Alignment on Gas Processing in Timor-Leste within the Greater Sunrise Framework

On July 28, the Minister of Petroleum and Mineral Resources, Francisco da Costa Monteiro, received a delegation from Woodside Energy, led by Julie Fallon, Executive Vice-President for Technical and Energy Development, for a meeting on the development of the Greater Sunrise fields.

During the meeting, the parties focused on the Timor-Leste Liquefied Natural Gas (TLNG) option, which the most recent studies have identified as the most viable path, both from a commercial and strategic point of view. Both delegations reaffirmed their commitment to moving the project forward, based on structured negotiations and guided by three fundamental principles: good faith, compromise and alignment of interests.

Following the meeting, the Ministry of Petroleum and Mineral Resources will accompany the Woodside Energy delegation on a two-day visit to the South Coast, passing through Suai and Natarbora. This trip will allow us to see the existing infrastructure and the areas designated for the future installation of a natural gas liquefaction (LNG) unit, as well as petrochemical and refining complexes. These facilities will be responsible for receiving and processing gas from the Greater Sunrise fields. The program of the visit includes visits to Suai Airport, the site of the Suai Logistics Support Base, the areas of new community housing estates and other strategic infrastructure points.

The Executive Vice-President of Woodside Energy recognized the importance of direct contact on the ground and expressed her appreciation for the opportunity to learn more about national development priorities and Timor-Leste's strategic vision for the South Coast region.

Minister Francisco Monteiro reaffirmed that the governments of Timor-Leste and Australia, together with the Greater Sunrise Joint Venture partners (TIMOR GAP, E.P., Woodside Energy and Osaka Gas), are currently negotiating the Petroleum Mining Code, the Production Sharing Contract and the Fiscal Regime that will form the legal and contractual basis of the project.

He also reiterated the Timorese state's ongoing efforts to develop the necessary infrastructure, from Covalima to Natarbora, with a view to achieving its long-term vision of creating a solid and sustainable national industry. **END**

Governu no Woodside Reforsa Aliñamentu kona-ba Prosesamentu Gás iha Timor-Leste iha Ámbitu Greater Sunrise

Ministru Petróleu no Rekursus Minerais, Francisco da Costa Monteiro, iha loron 28 fulan-jullu, simu delegasaun ida husi empresa Woodside Energy, ne'ebé lidera husi Julie Fallon, Vise-Prezidente Ezekutiva ba Dezenvolvimentu Tékniku no Enerjétiku, iha sorumutu ida kona-ba dezenvolvimentu kampu Greater Sunrise.

Iha sorumutu ne'e, parte sira ko'alia liu kona-ba opsaun Timor-Leste Liquefied Natural Gas (TLNG – Gás Natural Liquefeito de Timor-Leste), ne'ebé estudu foin lalais ne'e identifika hanesan dalan ne'ebé viável liu, tantu husi pontu de vista komersial nune'e mós estratéjiku. Delegasaun rua ne'e reafirma sira-nia kompromisu atu avansa projetu ne'e, bazeia ba negosiasaun estruturadu ne'ebé orienta husi prinsípius fundamentais tolu: boa fé, kompromisu, no aliñamentu ba interese sira.



Hafoin sorumutu, Ministériu Petróleu no Rekursus Minerais akompaña delegasaun Woodside Energy iha vizita loron rua ba Kosta Súl, liuliu iha parte Suai no Natarbora. Dezlokasaun ne'e sei permite atu halo observasaun ba infraestruturas ne'ebé iha ona no área sira ne'ebé dezinadu ba futuru instalasaun unidade likefasaun gás naturál (GNL), no mós kompleksu petrokímikus no refinarias. Ekipamentu sira-ne'e sei responsavel hodi simu no prosesa gás hosi kampu Greater Sunrise nian iha territóriu tomak. Programa vizita inklui vizita ba Aeroportu Suai, Baze Apoiu Lojístika Suai, zona ba bairru rezidénsia komunitária foun no pontu infraestrutura estratéjika sira seluk.

Governante ne'e mós reafirma esforsu kontínuu Estadu timoroan nian ba dezvoltamentu infraestruturas ne'ebé presiza, hosi Kovalima to'o Natarbora, ho objetivu atu konkretiza ninia vizaun ba tempu naruk hodi kria indústria petrolífera nasional ida ne'ebé sólidu no sustentável.
