Instruction to Bidders

- The proposal <u>must be sealed</u> and directly submitted to COMPANY in One (1) Original and Two (2) copies with electronic native files on CD Room to the address details below.

- The submitted proposal to the COMPANY shall be irrevocable for a period of 3 months or until the bidding process in completing whichever is longer.
- Correspondence during the proposal period for commercial clarification and technical clarification, including interpretation and clarification on the ITB shall be addressed to <u>procurement.dept@timorgap.com</u>
- Deadline for submitting requests for clarifications/ questions is 5 (five) days before the deadline

Instruction to Bidders......Cont'd



- Proposal opening date 19 August 2015 at 16:30pm
- The proposal must be prepared in English and use currency of USD
- Contract will be awarded to only 1 Contractor
- Advanced Payment upon signing of contract is allowed up to a maximum of 10% of Total Contract Price.
- The successful Bidder must deliver to TIMOR GAP, a Performance Security equal to 10% of contract amount after seven days from the notification of intend to award.
- The liquidated damages for delay shall be 0.3% of the price of the Contract per day of delay, up to a maximum of 5% of the final price of the Contract.
- The project is intended to complete in a 180 days period of time. The project will be started from 1st October until 31st March 2016.
- Bidders are mandatory required to abide all applicable law of Republic Democratic of Timor-Leste (RDTL) in connection to this project.

Evaluation Method



1. Vendor Eligibility

All bids will be examined to be considered as eligible based on following criteria

- Provide an authentic copy of its valid Business Registration Certificate (at least 3 months). Bidder must legally authorized and hold consultant services license. Bid submitted in other form of license will result to the disqualification (ex. Supplier, construction, etc.)
- Provide an authentic tax certificate from authorized institution.

2. Technical Evaluation

 Technical evaluation will be conducted against pre-established criteria and weights as described in Part D.

(Only bids pass minimum passing score of 80 points out of 100 points will be considered for financial evaluation)

3. Commercial Evaluation

Financial proposal score will be evaluated using following formula;

$$Score = \frac{Lowest \ Price}{Bidder \ Price} X 50$$

3	Bidder C	\$ 150,000.00	$= \frac{100,000.00}{150,000.00} \times 50 = 33.33$

Award Criteria



 An award criteria to be used in selecting the most responsive Proposal is the *Highest Combined Scoring Method*, using 50%-50% distribution for Technical and Financial Proposals, where the minimum passing score of technical proposal is 80 points out of 100 points.

Award Criteria....Cont'd

Content of Proposal



- 1. Signed Acknowledgement Letter/Confidentiality Agreement (Article 24)
- 2. Technical competence & expertise of the firm: Bidder's specialized knowledge, experience in work of a similar nature and experience on projects in the region. Availability of financial resources such as liquid assets, bank deposits, lines of credit or other financial means, to meet the project cash flow requirements. Project management control.
- 3. Execution strategy: Bidder shall describe the sequence of activities plan, realistic and efficient to the implementation of project. Equipment's and tools to be utilized for this project. Bidder is also require to propose timeline to complete the work. Bidder shall propose man-hours required for each discipline. Provide plan regarding commitment to safety for workers and environment protection.
- 4. Key Personnel
 - CV's, Certificate/Diploma for Project Manager, Chemical Engineer, Hydrologist, Ecologist, Environmentalist
- 5. Local content or local participation
 Plan to procure services, equipment and consumables required from domestic sources.

Content of Proposal......Cont'd



Commercial Proposal

The commercial proposal shall contain the following items as a minimum.

- Price must be a lump sump and inclusive all applicable tax include direct and indirect cost.
- ☐ Resident Company: 4%
- Non Resident Company: 10%

- III. Bidder must provide the breakdown price for man-hour rates, accommodations, transportation, etc.
