

# Aligning SDGs with National Priorities: Strategic Development Plan



### Comparing SDG Targets to SDP sub-goals:

- The SDGs are composed of 169 targets, while SDP goals consist of 149 sub-goals.
  - 15 of the 17 SDGs can be aligned with the SDP goals.
  - 58 SDG targets can be aligned to SDP sub-goals with varying degrees of proximity.
  - Main gaps in fulfilling most of the targets comes from areas that are not addressed in the SDPs, for example, Goal 17 (19 targets) that relates to sustainable development financing.
  - Much like the SDP goals, these is a matter of articulation, that is, adding more details and specificity to the SDP sub-goals.
    - For example: "Forest, land and sea better protected" vs. SDG target 'by 2020, sustainably manage and protect marine and coastal ecosystems to avoid significant adverse impacts, including by strengthening their resilience, and take action for their restoration, to achieve healthy and productive oceans."

## Aligning SDGs with National Priorities: Strategic Development Plan



- Several SDP Goals can be applied to many SDGs. E.g., **SDP Goal 4: "The Development needs of the present generation in Timor-Leste are met without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs"** can be applied to:
  - SDG 12: Ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns.
  - SDG 13: Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts.
  - SDG 14: Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development.
  - SDG 15: Protect, restore and promote sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, and halt and reverse land degradation and halt biodiversity loss.
- Next Steps: Conduct review of the SDP. Where possible, improve alignment to the SDGs without sacrificing our national priorities.
